

**Inside Tucson Business  
2017 Executive Excellence Awards**

Judges for the event will be assigned select categories to judge. Care will be taken to divvy up categories, so single judges will be able to perform their duties in a reasonable time period. For example, if a single category has 15 nominations, a single judge may receive only one category to judge. Another judge may receive two or three categories with only 3-4 nominations in each. Regardless of how many categories received, time commitment should be only a 1-2 hours maximum for judging.

Nominations ask for a written narrative of no more than 250 words. This narrative is used as the basis for the judging. Each category will be judged by more than one judge and ranking results will determine Finalists (1<sup>st</sup> place, 2<sup>nd</sup> place and 3<sup>rd</sup> place).

Categories for CFO's are: Large Company, Small/Medium Company, Non-Profit, and Government/Education. Judges will use a numeric system to rate each nomination submitted.

We ask that a judge recuse themselves from any category in which they see a potential conflict of interest.
